accruing to us and to the public from the construction of a public road through our lands, we do hereby give
grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, its successors or assigns, a right of way hereinafter
described, over and across the lands of the undersigned in Shelby County, Ala., for a public road; which
right of way shall be 66 feet in width or 33 feet in width on each side of the center line of said road, as it
is now located and staked out by the State Highway Department, or as much of our lands as is required to
make a 66 foot right of way, across our lands which are located and described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land 33 feet wide lying on the right of the centerline beginning at station 1089 plus 70 and ending at station 1090 plus 85 as now staked out by the highway department.

and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction of said road, we here by release the county from all consequential damages, present or prospective to our property, arising out of the construction, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged.
