A strip of land 33 feet wide beginning at station 1058 plus 60, thence to station 1065 plus 75 where said strip of land becomes 66 feet wide lying 33 feet on each side of the centerline, thence to station 1072 plus 02 where said strip of land becomes 33 feet wide lying on the left of the centerline, thence to station 1079 plus 48 and end of said strip of land.
