W. R. Wellborn being first duly sworn, deposes and says, that he has known the following described land, situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

The SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$, the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and that part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ lying north and west of the old Birmingham-Montgomery highway, all in Section 12, Township 20, Range 3 West,

for a period of more than 10 years, that this land has been owned by O. D. Kirkpatrick and his successors in title since the month of March, 1933; that said land has been occupied continuously by the said O. D. Kirkpatrick, his successors in title or their tenants since the date it was purchased by O. D. Kirkpatrick; that about 123 acres of said land has been under cultivation or used for pasture land continuously by the above named parties since its purchase by the said O. D.
