I, Frank Lockhart, of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do hereby make, publish, and declare this to be my last will and testament, hereby revoking all former wills made by me.

I.

It is my will, and I hereby direct, that all of my just debts, including the expenses of my last illness, burial, and the reasonable cost of placing stone markers at my grave, shall be first paid out of my estate.

II.

For many years my sister, Jamie Lockhart, and I have been thrown together by reason of many circumstances. She herself is crippled and on my part I have been crippled by reason of a loss of leg which occurred several years ago. She has nursed me and has taken care of me. Accordingly, after Item 1. of my will, as herein above fixed and set forth, has been taken care of out of my estate, I give, devise and bequeath to my said sister, Janie Lockhart, the full balance and residue of my estate of whatever kind or nature, including all of my property or interest in property, or equity in property whether real or personal or mixed, wherever situated.

III.

I nominate, constitute, and appoint my said sister, Janie Lockhart, as Executrix of this, my last will and testament, and I hereby direct that my said Executrix shall not be required to give bond, or file an inventory or appraisement of my estate in any court and shall not be required to make any accounting or final settlement of my estate in any court.
