Personally appeared before me, Edna L. Parente, a Notary Public in and for said State and County, Lt. Colonel, J. C. Burton, who is known to me and who being by me duly sworn says:

My name is J. C. Burton, and I am presently in the United States Army, and was, for the past several years, before my entry in the service, a practicing attorney at the Birmingham, Alabama Bar.

On the 4th day of March, 1939, R. R. Gallops was the grantee in a certain deed executed by Margaret W. Burton (who is my wife) and Myrtle O. Wilkinson (who was at the time of the execution thereof the wife and now the widow of Frank Wilkinson, who was a practicing attorney at the Birmingham, Alabama Bar); and that said deed was signed by Margaret W. Burton, Myrtle O. Wilkinson and that this affiant and Frank Wilkinson joined in the conveyance as the respective husbands of the grantors.

That the deed executed referred to herein was delivered by the affiant to the said R. R. Gallops. Affiant further states that he has been informed and on such information avers that the aforesaid deed was never recorded, and was either lost or misplaced by the said R. R. Gallops, who is one and the same person as appears as grantor in that certain mortgage executed to Margaret W. Burton and Myrtle O. Wilkinson, which mortgage is in the sum of \$1,000.00, and is dated March the 4th, 1939 and was executed simultaneously with the deed referred to herein, and said mortgage appears of record in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, in volume 179 on page 323. The land conveyed to the said Gallops by the said deed was the same land described in the aforementioned mortgage.
