## AFFIDAVIT

Haywood, and all being one and the same party, and being the grantee in that certain deed V. B. Davis to Daniel Haywood recorded in Deed Book 32, on page 254, and being the grantor in that deed from W. D. Haywood to L. D. Hand, recorded in Deed Book 70, on page 566; and the grantee in that certain deed from Saginaw Lime and Lumber Company to D. Haywood recorded in Deed Book 108, on page 583; all in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further says that he is acquainted with Lillie Burt, who is the one and the same person as Lillie Burt Whitson who is shown as grantee in the deed recorded in Deed Book 69 on page 214 and Deed Book 68 on page 496, and the grantor in that certain deed recorded in Deed Book 98 on page 324 all in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further says that he was one of the grantors in that timber deed to the Alabama Cooperate Company as shown of recorded in Deed Book 105, on page 224, and that said Alabama Cooperage Company did not exercise this option of extension of said contract from year to year as given in said timber deed, and that no payment or no act has been exercised in fulfillment of said option, and that said Alabama Cooperage Company has abandoned the same.
