

DECREE REMOVING DISABILITIES OF NONAGE

IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF Jeannette C. Borland, to have Morton H. Borland, Jr., relieved of the disabilities of nonage.

This cause coming on to be heard in term time and having been submitted for Decree on the Petition and ex-parte affidavits of Leila Borland Brown and W. S. Borland thereupon, upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that Morton H. Borland, Jr., a Minor, who is over the age of Eighteen years, be, and he is Relieved of the Disabilities of Nonage, and he is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which he is entitled; to purchase Real or Personal Estate, to sell and to convey, and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if he were twenty-one years of age.

It is further decreed that the said Jeannette C. Borland pay the costs of this proceeding, for which Execution may issue.
