

POWER OF ATTORNEY

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that J.A. King, of the City of Pelham, State of Alabama, is hereby given power of attorney to satisfy for and release of record in the name of the BOARD OF CHURCH EXTENSION OF THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH, SOUTH, a corporation created and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Kentucky a certain Indenture of Mortgage bearing date the 25th day of Janury, 1943, A.D., and made and executed by J. A. King, Don Busby, S.C. Busby, W.M. Cumberland, and W.L. the indebtedness represented by said Mortgage having been fully paid, satisfied and discharged.

The power of attorney herein granted is to cease with the satisfaction and release of the Mortgage herein described.
