Transmission Line Permit

We, John H. Farr and wife Mary Farr for and in consideration of the sum of One & No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

Part of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 18, Tp. 22, R 1 E described as follows, begin at the North West corner of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 18, thence run south 3° 30' East along west boundary of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and along west boundary of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 1834.2 feet, then turn an angle of 75° 00' to the left in a Southeasterly direction 127.0 feet for point of beginning of the tract of land herein described, then turn an angle of 23° 30' to the right southerly 453.2 feet, then turn an angle of 122° 15' to the left North East 287.3 feet, then turn an angle of 3° 30' to the right northeast 197.6 feet, then turn an angle of 83° 45' to the left northwest 415. feet, then turn an angle of 103° 5' to the left southwest 319.4 feet to point of beginning.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
