## Special Pole Line Permit

STATE OF ALABAMA )

We, D. A. Thomas and W. C. Scott, as Trustees under a deed of trust recorded on September 23, 1943, in the office of the Probate Judge of Shelby County, Alabama, in Deed Book volume 117, page 274, for and in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 (\$1.00) Dollars, to us in hand paid by the Alabama Power Company, a Corporation, receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to the said Alabama Power Company, a Corporation, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain over and upon the land hereinafter described and at the points hereinafter indicated, its lines of poles and appliances necessary in connection therewith, for the transmission of electric power, with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires, and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles, together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines and also the right to trim such trees that would endanger said lines.

The easement hereby granted is over, upon and across certain lots, blocks, streets, avenues and alleys as shown on a map hereto attached and made a part hereof, being a photostat of a map made by I. S. Gillespie, Registered Land Surveyor, on December 8, 1943, and being a map of certain lands in the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter and the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter and the Southeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter and the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, all in Section 19, Township 22, Range 3 West, Shelby County, Alabema, and being known as a map of the Town of Aldrich, Alabema.


