 --Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to con-  
 struct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith,  
 as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric  
 power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to  
 permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the fol-  
 lowing described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

Begin at the Southwest corner of Bob Coker lot in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and <sup>on</sup> the East side  
 of Birmingham-Montgomery Highway run thence north 88° 30' East 420 feet to a point,  
 thence South 19° 30' East 210 feet, thence South 88° 30' West 420 feet to East margin of  
 R/W of said highway, thence North 19° 30' West 210 feet along East margin of said R/W  
 210 feet to point of beginning Sec. 24, Tp. 20 R 3 W.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use  
 thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep  
 clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
