To have and To Hold to the said George Huddleston, his heirs, successors and assigns forever.

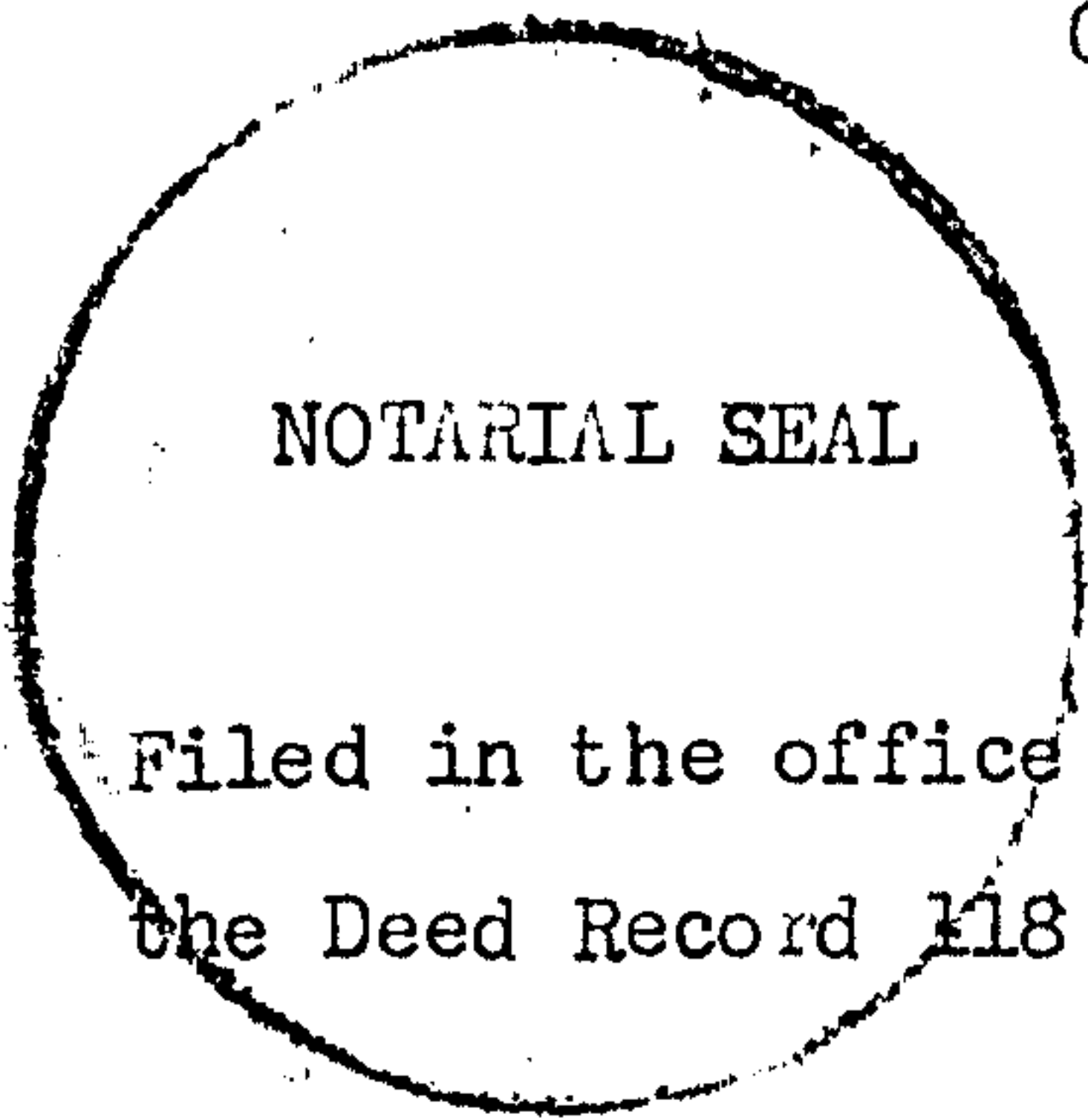
