DEED OF CORRECTION

THIS INDENTURE by and between Calera Lime Corporation, a corporation, party of the first part and Coosa Land Company, Inc., a corporation, party of the second part, witnesseth that,

WHEREAS, on February 15, 1943, party of the first part executed and delivered to the party of the second part a deed which is recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate in and for said County in said State in Deed Book 114, at page 432, and,

WHEREAS, it now appears that a mistake was made in describing the hereinfater described land in that it was described as being North of Ebenezer road, and,

WHEREAS, parties hereto are desirous of correcting said error.

NOW THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises and the further consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars to party of the first part in hand paid by party of the second part, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, party of the first part does hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey, to party of the second part its successors and assigns the following described real estate situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 29, Township 21, Range 2 West, which lies East of the L & N Railroad and South of the old Ebenezer road.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto party of the second part its successors and assigns forever.

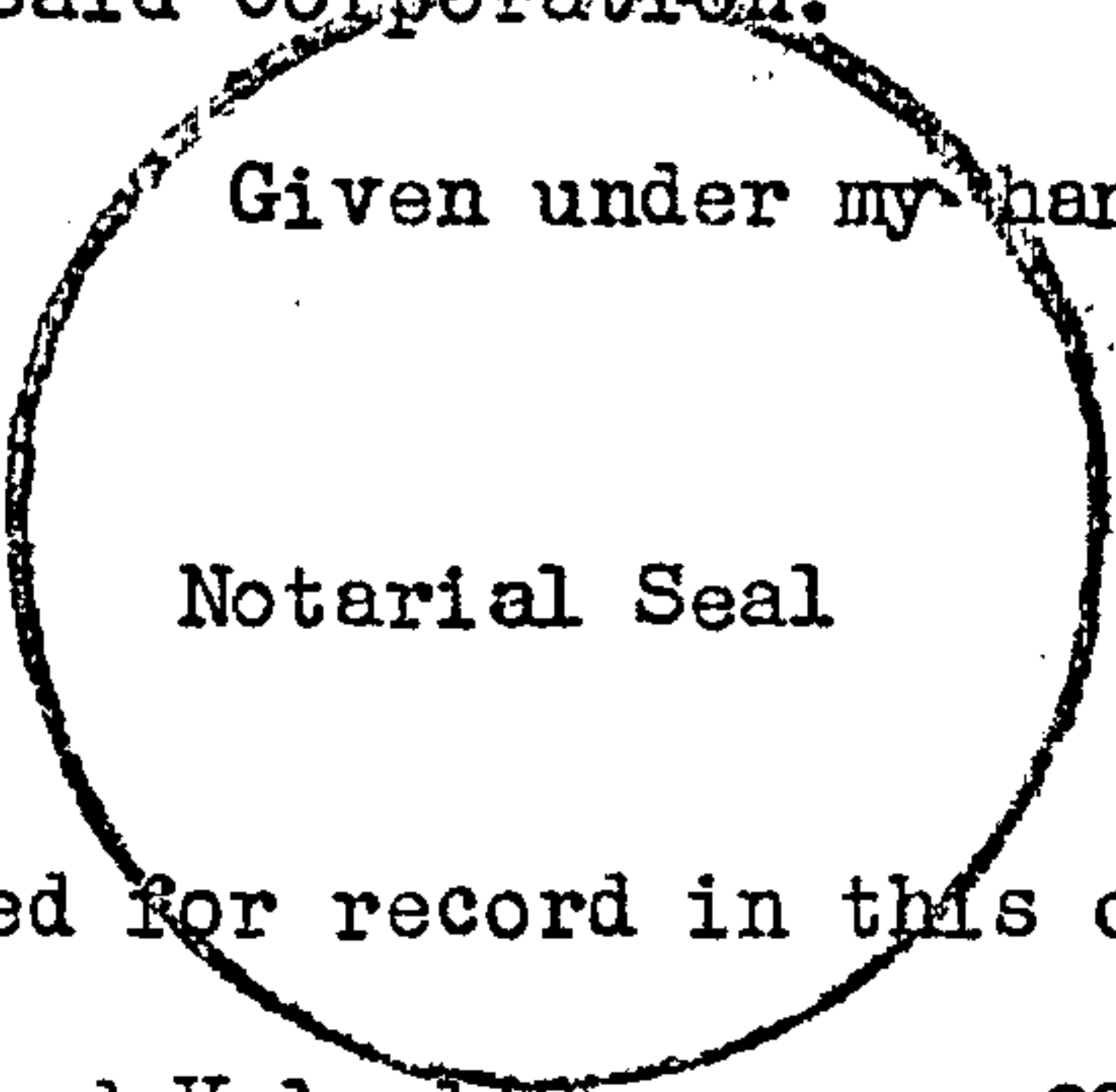
