TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, William Osley of Shelby County has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States, a certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said William Osley according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled "An Act making further provisions for the sale of the Public Lands", for

the North East quarter of the North west quarter of Section Seventeen in Township Twenty One of Range Two west in the District of lands subject to sale at Tuscaloosa Alabama containing Thirty nine acres and ninety seven and three quarter hundredths of an acre. according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said William Osley.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and, by these presents, do give and grant, unto the said William Osley, and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

To Have and to Hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances, of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said William Osley and to his heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I Andrew Jackson PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made Patent and the Seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

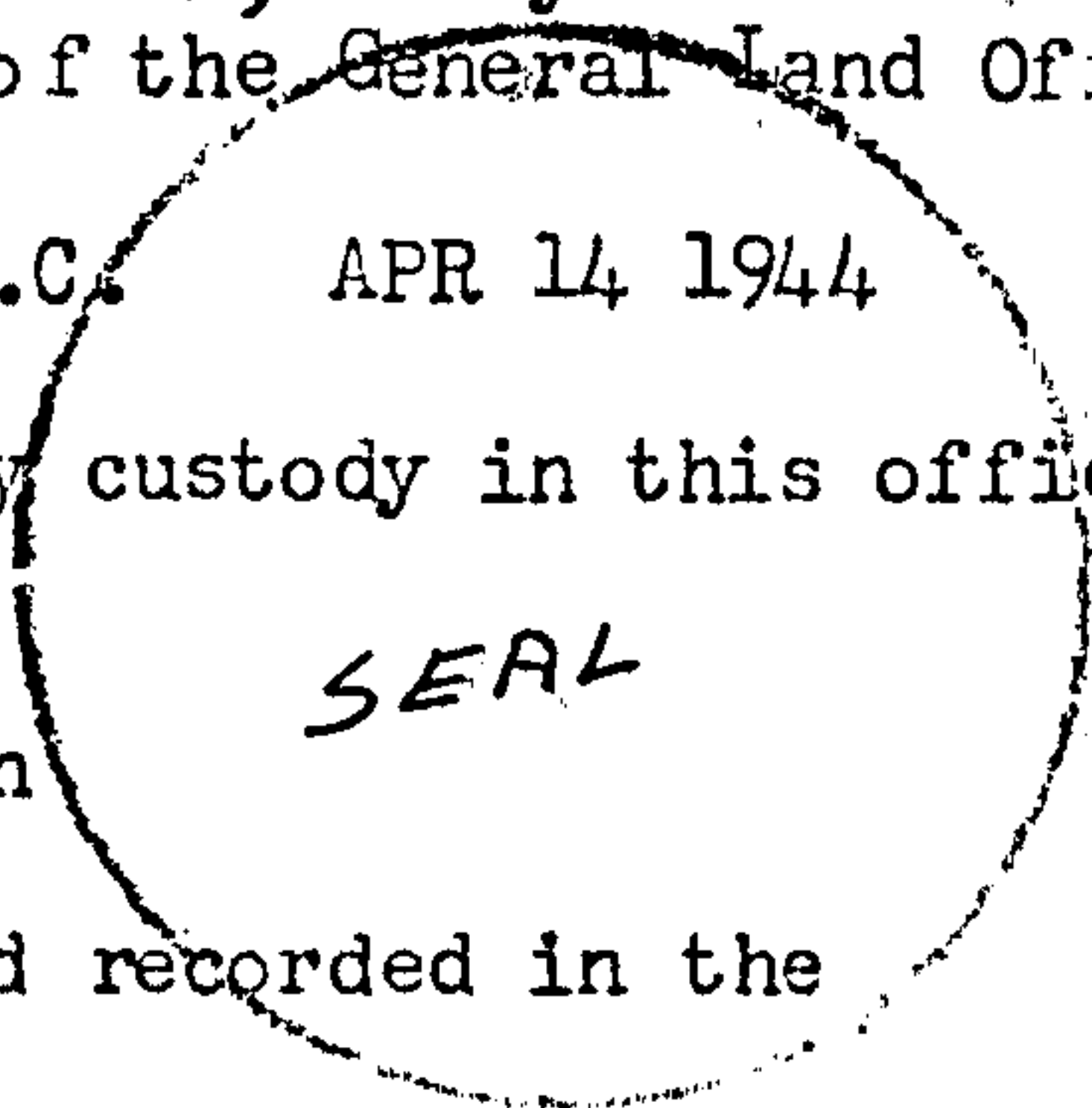
