Oliver, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and for the purpose of correcting errors inadvertently made in deeds heretofore executed, we, the said Arthur A. Oliver and Marie Kathryn Oliver, his wife, do hereby REmise, release, quit claim and convey unto the said George C. Oliver, all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described lands, situate, lying and being in Shelby County, Alabama, viz:

All those portions of the East Half of Northwest Quarter (Ez of NWL), Northeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (NE of SWk), Northwest Quarter of Southeast Quarter (NW是 of SE是), southwest quarter of Northeast quarter (SW是 of NE是), and Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter (NWL of NEL), of Section 3, Township 24, Range 13 which lies South of the Southern Railway and east of that certain Division Fence which commences at or near a Post Oak Tree near the crossing of the Salem Dirt Road and the said Southern Railway, and runs thence from said Post Oak Tree in a southerly direction to a certain Pine Tree, and from said Pine Tree South to the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (NE£ of SWh) of said Section 3, Township 24, Range 13, and all lying and being in Section 3, Township 24, Range 13; except, however, that certain lot or parcel of land conveyed by deed bearing date the 11th day of January, 1889, from C.D.
