Jeffers, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we, the said George C. Oliver and wife, May Station Oliver, Arthur A. Oliver and wife, Marie Kathryn Oliver, Annie McLean Oliver, a widow, and Herndon A. Oliver, Jr., and wife Mary Currell Oliver, do remise, release, quit claim and convey unto said Laura O. Jeffers, all our right, title, interest and claim in or to the following described real estate, situate, lying and being in Shelby County, Alabama, viz.:

All those portions of the East Half of Northwest Quarter (E) of NWA), Northeast Quarter of Southwest Quarter (NE of SW4), Northwest Quarter of Southeast Quarter (NWA of SEA), Southwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter (SWA of NBA), and Northwest Quarter of Northeast Quarter (NWA of NBA), of Section 3, Township 24, Range 13, which lies South of the Southern Railway and West of that certain Division Fence which commences at or near a Post Oak Tree near the crossing of the Salem Dirt Road and the said Southern Railway, and runs thence from said Post Oak Tree in a southerly direction to a certain Pine Tres, and from said Pine Tree South to the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter (N時 of S時) of said Section 3, Township 24, Range 13, all lying and being in said Section 3, Township 24, Range 13; and also that certain lot or parcel of land conveyed by deed bearing date the 11th day of January, 1889, from C.
