DECREE ON PETITION OF ELIZABETH WINGATE AS TRUSTEE OF THE ESTATE
OF JULIUS B. COOPER, DECEASED

THIS CAUSE coming on to be heard upon the verified petition of Elizabeth Wingate, as trustee of the Estate of Julius B. Cooper, deceased, to have a successor trustee appointed to succeed John Francis Cooper, a former trustee, now deceased, and it appearing to the Court that all of the cestui que trust have nominated and are requesting the Court to appoint Maud Adams Cooper, as such successor trustee without bond, and no reason appearing to the Court why said request should not be grant, it is, therefore,

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Maud Adams Cooper is hereby appointed as trustee of the Estate of Julius B. Cooper, deceased, and as such trustee she is hereby relieved from giving bond for the faithful performance of her duties as such trustee,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that said estate continue to be administered by the Probate Court of Jefferson County, Alabama, until the same is removed from said Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the costs be taxed against the petitioner.
