AFFIDAVIT

THE STATE OF ALABAMA,

SHELBY COUNTY.

Before me the undersigned authority in and for said County in said State, personally appeared C. R. Knowles, who being first duly sworn on oath says that affiant has for the past 50 years been familiar with the property of O. L. Logan and wife, A. B. Logan, described as the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 6, the North $\frac{1}{8}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 7, and a part of fractional Section 12 in the NE corner of said Section 12, running East and West 110 yards and North and South 220 yards, all of said property in Township 24, Range 13 East, in Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further says that said property was for many years prior to December 22, 1910, in the actual physical possession of John I. Standifer, who had the same cultivated and exercised the usual actual ownership incident to property of this kind and that on December 22, 1910, the said John I. Standifer and wife, Eu-dellar Standifer conveyed the property to J. W. Reid and immediately went into possession thereof and resided thereon and cultivated the said property until he sold it to G. D. Reid in 1920 and that the said G. D. Reid and his wife, on October 14, 1921, sold the property to O. L. Logan and his wife, A. B. Logan, and that the said O. L. Logan and wife resided on and cultivated said property during all of the time since and that they exercised all of the usual acts of ownership of said property and were holding under claim of ownership and residing thereon and cultivated said land for more than 22 years and that no one else had any possession whatever of said property inconsistent with the ownership and rights of Mr. and Mrs. Logan.
