Beg at South west corner of Block 4 according to Safford Survey of the town of Shelby and recorded in office of Probate Judge at Columbiana, Alabama, Thence south 88 degrees 30 minutes east along the north boundary line at Parke Avenue 273 feet then north at right angle to Parker Avenue 264 feet to South boundary line of 6 Avenue, then West along south boundary line of 6 Avenue 273 ft to North West corner of said Block 4, Thence South 1 degree 30 minutes west along Street line to point of beginning. Containing 1.65 acres more or less Situated in Shelby County.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.
