AFFIDAVIT

Personally came and appeared before me, S. A. Lokey, a Notary Public in and for the State of Alabama at Large, F. S. Farr, who after first being by me duly sworn according to Law to speak the truth, desposeth and says:

I am one and the same person as the F. S. Farr, who made an affidavit on July 18, 1941 which is recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County Alabama in Deed Book 111 at page 645, concerning the following described land:

The Southeast Quarter of Section 3; the east half of the Northeast quarter, the east half of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3; the East half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 3; the East half of the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 3; all in Township 21 Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama, also the Northeast Quarter of Section 10, and the West half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 10; all in Township 21 Range 1 East, Shelby County, Alabama.

The Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 34 Township 20, Range 1 East was inadvertently omitted from the fore-going description in said affidavit. It was included in the deed from Nathaniel J. Mitchem and his wife Endocie Mitchem to John W. Bolin, dated November 21, 1882 and recorded in deed Book 5 at page 226 in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and in the deed from N. J. Mitchem and wife Endocia Mitchem (the said N. J. Mitchem and Nathaniel J. Mitchem being one and the same person) to John W. Bolin, dated November 20, 1982 and recorded in Deed Book 6 at page 538 in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

Everything I said in my affidavit of July 18, 1941 in regard to the lands purchased by John W. Bolin from Nathaniel J. Mitchem applies with equal force to the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 34, Township 20 Range 1 East. The said John W. Bolin went into possession of this forty along with the other land and cultivated it as a part of his farm until his death and his heirs continued in possession until the time of the sale to L. H. Ellis.
