Personally appeared before me, the undersigned authority in and for said County, in said State, Aaron Ash, who being by me first duly sworn, deposes and says:

I was the husband of Maggie A. Ash during her lifetime. She died on the 5th day of June, 1942. Her sole surviving heirs were me, her husband, and Benjamin A. Ash, Margaret A. Brown, Katherine A. Sawls and Josephine A. Ash being our children. She left surviving no other child or children nor any descendants of any deceased child or children.

Maggie A. Aash left no debts. Her estate was never administered because there was no reason for doing so.

Maggie A. Ash during her lifetime was owner of an interest in the following described property situated in Shelby County, Alabama, to-wit:

Beginning on the eastern boundary line of Section 4 to 22 Range 2 West, at a point 881 feet from the SE corner of the NE₄ of NE₄ of said section, thence north along said section line and along the eastern boundary line of Section 33 Tp 21 Range 2 West 870 feet, thence west to the right of way of the South & North Alabama Railroad, thence south along the said right of way to the south boundary line of said section 33, thence east along said boundary line of Section 33 to the NW corner of the NE₄ of NW₄ of said section 4, thence south to the NW corner of the land of Sallie Byrd, thence east along the line of the land of Sallie Byrd to the point of beginning, containing 80 acres more or less, except one acre deeded to the Baptist Church and except ½ of an acre reserved as a cemetery lot, on which is now located a cemetery, and lying along northern boundary line of said land.
