Epperson and by mistake the initials were written, E. M., instead of C. L. and we signed said deed and delivered it to C. L. Epperson being under the impression that he was the grantee named in said deed. The said C. L. Epperson went into possession of said land under said deed, and has since been in posession and no one by the name

of E. M. Epperson has ever been in possession of said land or laid any claim thereto. The land in question is described as follows:
