All of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter, EXCEPT 10 acres of equal width across the South side thereof. Also, that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter which lies South of a line beginning at the Southwest corner of said forty acres and running thence North 242 feet to an old road; run thence South 78 degrees and 30 minutes East along said road to the Southeast corner of said forty acres, all in Section 8, Township 21, Range 2 West.

Affiant further says that he is familiar with the description of the right of way given in that certain deed from John W. Naish to John E. Morris, dated June 5, 1895, and recorded in Deed Book 19, on page 198, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama, and which right of way was later conveyed by John E. Morris to the Saginaw Lumber Company on January 2d., 1896, as shown in Deed Book 19, on page 202, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further says that said last named right way for a wagon road does not cross any part of the above described lands owned by your affiant, but said above described road now constitutes and marks the North boundary line of the 33 acres owned by your affiant and described in this affidavit; affiant says that the only right of way across the above described lands is a thirty foot strip for a tram track conveyed to John E. Morris in 1895 by John W. Naish as shown in Deed Book 19, Page 201; that said right of way is not now in use and has not been in use for the past eight years.
