Lucas and wife, Marie Lucas, for and in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon fromtime to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

All of that part of the place of farm formerly known as the John P. West Place, or farm, which lies on the west side of the Montevallo and Elyton Public Road, or Montevallo and Birmingham Public Road, and is further described as the west half of the southwest quarter of Section 33, Township 21, Range 3 West, containing in all about 90 acres, saving and excepting therefrom that part sold to the Southern Railway Company for right of way.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full emjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other instructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
