KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable consideration, to John Gresky in hand paid by Luda Gresky the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged I do remise, release, quit claim and convey to the said Luda Gresky, my wife, all my right, title, interest, and claim in or to the following described real estate, to-wit:

A certain house and lot situated in Montevallo, Shelby County, Alabama and further described as beginning at the Southwestern corner of Block and Valley Street and running in Southwestern direction parallel with Valley Street to the lot of C.O. Woolley approximately 180 feet, thence at right angles to Valley Street 150 feet, thence parallel with Valley Street to Block Street approximately 180 feet, thence parallel with Block Street 150 feet to point of beginning, situated in Shelby County, Alabama

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD to the said Luda Gresky, her heirs and assigns forever.
