IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF Dovie Lucas Shaw, to have Truman Shaw, RELIEVED OF THE DISABILITIES OF NONAGE.

This cause coming on to be heard in term time having been submitted for Decree on the Petition and ex-parte affidavits of Dovie Lucas Shaw, L. E. Shaw and Truman Shaw, thereupon, upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that Truman Shaw, a Minor, who is over the age of Eighteen yearsbe, and he is Relieved of the Disabilities of Nonage, and he is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which he is entitled; to purchase Real or Personal Estate, to sell and to convey, and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if he were twenty-one years of age.

It is further decreed that the said Truman Shaw pay the costs of proceeding, for which Execution may issue.

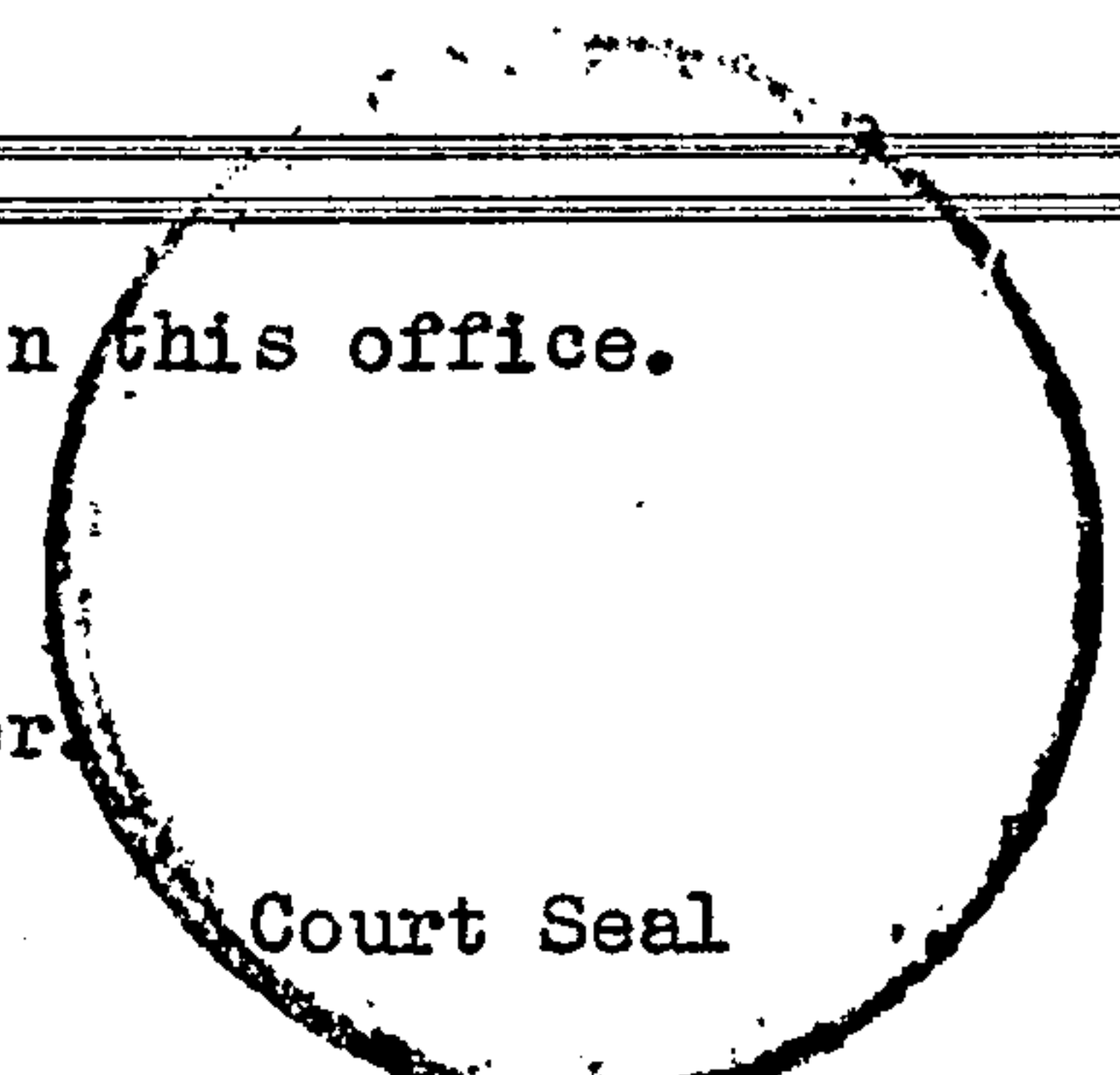
