

## AFFIDAVIT

Personally appeared before me, L.C. Albright, a Notary Public, in and for said State and County, Mrs. Edna Skelton, who is known to me and who being by me first duly sworn says:

I am the widow of Isaac N. Skelton, who departed this life in Jefferson County, Alabama in September 1944.
