Horsley the receipt whereof is acknowledged we the said Harry Gordon and wife, Ila Gordon, do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said W.J. Horsley the following described real estate, to-wit:

A lot in the town of Columbiana, Alabama, described as follows: Commencing at a point on the East side of Main Street in said town which point is 140 feet and 7 inches North of the North side of East College Street, and which point is the Pouthwest corner of the old Leonard Hotel Lot, and from said point run thence East along the South line of the old Leonard Hotel lot 212 feet; thence North and parallel with Main Street 25 feet; run thence West and parallel with the South line of said Hotel lot 212/ more or less to the East line of Main Street; run thence South along the East line of Main Street a distance of 25 feet to the point of beginning. Reserving and excepting an easement, or right of way, 15 feet in width across the lot herein conveyed, in the rear of any building which may be built on said lot, the West line of said easement, or right of way, as aforesaid, not to be more than 60 feet East from the East margin of Main Street.
