Certain parts of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter (pts. NE₄ of NE₄) of section three (3) and of the north half of the northwest quarter (pts. N₂ of NW₄) of section two (2), township twenty-four (24), North, Range Twelve (12) East and of Fractional sections twenty-eight and twenty-seven (pts. 28 & 27) Township twenty-two (22), South, Range three (3) West: which parts hereby conveyed being parts of the tract of land heretofore known as and called "The Holloway Place" located near the Town of Montevallo and which parts hereby conveyed are, together, particularly described.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
