LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF MRS. ELLA GLENN TEMPLETON

STATE OF ALABAMA:

JEFFERSON COUNTY:

I, the undersigned Mrs. Ella Glenn Templeton, of Birmingham, Jefferson County, State of Alabama, being of sound and disposing mind and memory and with full knowledge and cognizance of the matters hereinafter set forth, do hereby declare this to be my last will and testament, and do revoke all other and previous wills and testamentary dispositions before made by me.

ITEM # 1

I hereby nominate and appoint my beloved friend, Mr. L.B. Burch of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, as Executor of my will and direct that he shall not be required to give bond as such Executor; that he shall not be required to file any inventory or to account to any person or court for his actions in his official capacity and shall have the power to dispose by sale, exchange or otherwise of any of the property or effects over which he shall have control as such Executor, that he may invest or reinvest any of the funds which may come into his possession and under his control and dispose of it in any other way, as he shall in his discretion deem meet and any and all of my estate. And or all of which may be done without first obtaining permission of the Court or of any person and without any time giving an account therefor.

In the event the above named person nominated and appointed as my executor should fail and or refuse or otherwise be incapacitated from acting as such Executor, I do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved neice, Mrs. Alice Stevens, as Executrix of my will under the terms and conditions as set out in paragraph next hereinabove.

ITEM # 2

I hereby direct that all my just debts be paid.

ITEM # 3

I do hereby devise and bequeath all of my property, real, personal, and mixed to my beloved brother, Ed Glenn of Tulsa, Oklahoma and to my beloved sister, Mrs. Ida Coley of Birmingham, Jefferson County, Alabama, share and share alike.

- (a) In the event either of the above named devisees should predecease me, it is my wish and will that all of my property, real, personal, and mixed shall go to the survivor, in fee simple.
- (b) In the event both of the aforenamed devisees should predecease me, it is my wish and will that all of my property, real, personal, and mixed shall descend, in fee simple, to my beloved neice, Mrs. Alice Stevens.
- (c) In the event my beloved brother, Ed Glenn, and my beloved sister, Mrs. Ida Coley, and my beloved neice, Mrs. Alice Stevens, all should predecease me, it is my wish and will that all of my property, real, personal, and mixed, shall descend to such person or persons and in such order and shares as is provided for under the laws of Descent and Distribution of the State of Alabama, as though no will had ever been executed.
