IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF Virginia H. McGraw, to have Peggy Lee McGraw reliev^ed of the Disabilities of Nonage.

This cause coming on to be heard and having been submitted for Decree on the Petition and ex-parte affidavits of J. W. Florey and J. A. 
