To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, Rebecca J. Smith, of Dallas County, Alabama has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE at Tuscaloosa whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said Rebecca J. Smith according to the provisions of the Act of Congress of the 24th of April, 1820, entitled, "An act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for

The North half of the South East quarter of Section three in Township Twenty four of Range Thirteen East in the District of Lands subject to sale, at Tuscaloosa, Alabama, containing Seventy-nine acres, and Forty nine and a half hundredths of an acre, according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said Rebecca J. Smith.

NOW KNOW YE, That the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said Rebecca J. Smith and to her heirs, the said tract above described: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said Rebecca J. Smith and to her heirs and assigns forever.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Franklin Pierce PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these Letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL of the GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
