KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That, in consideration of TEN DOLLARS to the undersigned grantor, Gertrude L. hirkley, an unmarried woman, in hand paid by C. E. Jones, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, I, the said Gertrude L. Kirkley, an unmarried woman do grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said C. E. Jones the following described real estate situated, lying, and being in the County of Shelby, in the State of Alabama, to wit:

PARCEL ONE: A triangular tract of land containing 7 \frac{1}{2} acres, more or less, lying partly in the east half of the southeast quarter of Section 16, and partly in the west half of the southwest quarter of Section 15, all in Township 22, Range 3 West, and more particula 1/3 described by metes and bounds, as follows: Beginning at a point in the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of said Section 16 on the line dividing the land of the grantor (heretofore known as and called the Quinn land), and the land of the grantee, known as and called the Horace Butler Land, which point of beginning is 101 yards south of the point of intersection of said dividing line with the southeast edge, or margin of the Montevallo and Ashville public road and running thence south along said dividing line and projection thereof 787 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet, more or less, to the north line of the land heretofore known as and cakked "The Goodson Land," run thence east 840 feet; run thence in a northwesterly direction in a straight line to the point of beginning on said dividing line, which said tract of land herein conveyed is better described according to a recent survey as follows, to wit: Commencing at the southeast corner of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 16, Township 22, Range 3 West, and run thence North 3 degrees West a distance of 225 yards to a point of beginning: And from said point of beginning run thence south 87 degrees West 220 yards to a point, which is the line of the H.
