

AFFIDAVIT

JEFFERSON COUNTY

Before me the undersigned Notary Public in and for said County and State personally appeared George Huddleston who on oath says:

That on September 14, 1927 affiant received a deed from F.P. Chessser, F.H. Pearce and others conveying to affiant the N $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 8, T. 19, R. 1 W. and on November 20, 1931 affiant received a deed from the same grantors to the entire SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 8, T. 19, R. 1 W. and on October 31, 1927 affiant received a deed from the State of Alabama conveying to affiant the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 8 T. 19, R. 1 W. all in Shelby County, Alabama, and that affiant not later than November 20, 1931 went into actual possession of all of said lands and continuously since such date affiant has remained in actual, open, notorious and adverse possession of all of such lands and has assessed same for taxes every year and has paid the taxes thereon down to the present; that in the exercise of affiant's ownership and possession of said lands affiant deeded to the County a right of way for a public highway over and across same; that affiant during all of his possession has maintained on such lands posted notices against trespassing; that affiant during the year 1942 sold the timber from such lands and had same cut therefrom; that affiant has on many occasions walked over such lands and viewed same and asserted his ownership and possession; that in the year 1940 affiant built a frame house on the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 8 and has maintained and kept such house thereon down to the present; that affiant in the year 1938 had the lines of such land run by a surveyor; that at various times affiant has walked over such lands with prospective purchasers and offered same for sale; that during such entire time affiant's possession and acts thereof have been exclusive and against all persons and under claim of ownership; that such lands are known to affiant's neighbors and adjoining land owners as affiant's property and that no other person within affiant's knowledge has made any claim of ownership thereof.
