RIGHT-OF-WAY DEED FOR PUBLIC ROAD

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, GEORGE HUDSON AND WIFE ETHEL HUDSON of the County and State aforesaid, in and for the consideration of one dollar (\$1.00\$) in hand paid by Shelby County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for the further consideration of the benefit accruing to us and to the public from the construction or improvement of a public road through our lands, in Shelby County, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto Shelby County, its successors or assigns, a Right-of-way hereinafter described, over and across our said lands in Shelby County,

Alabama, for a public road; which right-of-way shall be (see below) feet in width on each side of the center line of said road, as it is now located and staked out by Shelby County or as much of our lands as is required to make a see below foot right-of-way across our lands, said right-of-way herein conveyed being more particularly described as follows, to wit: and as shown by the right-of-way map of SACP 414, as recorded in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County:

Beginning at station 313 / 97 of said Project, the south property line; thence 384.4 ft. north-westerly along a 7639.49 ft. radius curve westerly; thence 1490.7 ft. N21⁰02'W; thence 229.9 ft. north-westerly along a 5729.65 ft. radius curve, concave northeasterly, to station 335 / 02, the point of ending at the north property line.

Said strip of land being 40 ft. wide on each side of the centerline of said Project from station 313 / 97 to station 317 / 00, 40 ft. wide on the northeast and 70 ft. wide on the southwest side of said centerline from station 317 / 00 to station 319 / 00, 40 ft. wide on each side of said centerline from station 319 / 00 to station 321 / 25, 40 ft. wide on each side of said centerline, excluding area lying northeasterly of the centerline of the present road from station 321 / 25 to station 335 / 02.

Said strip of land lying in the NW of SE and the SW of Section 26, Tn. 21 S, Rn. 3 W and containing 2.1 acres, more or less, including area occupied by the present road.

To Have and To Hold by Shelby County, or its Assigns, and for and in consideration of the benefit to our property by reason of the construction or improvement of said road, we hereby release the County aforesaid, and all of its employees and officers, and the State of Alabama and all of its employees and officers from all consequential damages, present or prospective, to our property, arising out of the construction, improvement, maintenance or repair of said road, and that said road is a benefit to our property is hereby admitted and acknowledged. All agreements covering the moving, relocating and/or changing of the buildings and/or structures located wholly or partially on the above described right-of-way shall be in writing and approved by the State Highway Department before same shall be valid and binding on the said State Highway Department. The grantor hereby grants permission with right of ingress and egress to grantor's adjoining property at any time during construction period of project for purpose of moving grantor's buildings and/or structures from the above described right-of-way.
