

## AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned authority, in and for said County, in said State, personally appeared W.S. Stonecypher, who, being first duly sworn deposes and says that he resides in Shelby County, Alabama, and in the same community in which the hereinafter described lands are situated; that for a period of thirty-five years, last past, he has been acquainted with the location, ownership, boundaries, and use of the following described lands, to-wit:

The Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter; The Southwest diagonal one-half of the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 1, and the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 12, all in Township 22, Range 3 West;

Also, all of the Southwest Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 6, Township 22, Range 2 West, except that part conveyed to Joshua M. Frost by deed recorded in Deed Book 47, on page 147, in the office of the Judge of Probate of Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further says that when he first knew said lands that Jesse G. Frost was the owner and party in possession of said lands, and he continued in possession thereof until his death in 1930, and that since the death of the said Jesse G. Frost, his heirs at law through and by their tenant, J.M. Sorrell, have been in the continuous, notorious, and adverse possession of said lands, regularly cultivating the same in agricultural crops, and using other parts for pasture and as a residence.

Affiant further says that he knows that for more than thirty-five years that Jesse G. Frost, and since his death, his heirs-at-law, as aforesaid, have been, respectively, in the open, notorious, continuous, peaceable, and adverse possession of said lands, claiming the same as their own, respectively, and regularly exercising acts of ownership, as aforesaid, and that your affiant has never heard the title of the said Jesse G. Frost and his heirs, or those through whom they hold title, to be questioned in any way; affiant

further says that he is not of kin to any of the owners of the above and foregoing described lands and has no interest therein.
