DECREE OF DEVORCE

THIS CAUSE, coming on to be heard at this Term, was submitted upon the bill of complaint, decree pro confesso and testimony as noted by Register, and upon consideration thereof the Court is of the opinion that the Complainant is entitled to the relief prayed for in her said bill.

It is therefore Ordered, Adjudged and decreed by the Court tht the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the Complainant and Defendant be and the same are hereby dissolved, and the said Mrs. Ethel Bryan is forever divorced from the said J.T. Bryan for and on account of Respondent having become addicted to habitual drunkenness after marriage to Complainant, as alleged in said bill of complaint.

It is further ordered that the said Mrs. Ethel Bryan be and she hereby ^{is} permitted to again contract marriage upon the payment of the cost of court in this cause.

It is further ordered that the said J.T. Bryan pay the costs herein taxed for which execution may issue, and if such execution is returned "no property found" then execution for costs may issue against the said Mrs. Ethel Bryan.

It is further Ordered, Adjudged and Decreed that said Mrs. Ethel Bryan shall not marry against except to said J.T. Bryan until sixty days after this date, and if an appeal is taken within sixty days she shall not marry again except to said J.T. Bryan during the pendency of said appeal.

It is further ordered that execution for costs be stayed sixty days.
