CIRCUIT COURT OF SHELBY COUNTY, EQUITY DIVISION.

In the Matter of the Petition of A. G. Cupp, to have Weldon Cupp  
 relieved of the Disabilities of Nonage.

This cause coming on to be heard having been submitted for Decree on the Petition and Affidavit of Roland McDaniel, and Acceptance of Service of Weldon Cupp, thereupon, upon consideration thereof, it is ordered adjudged, and decreed by the Court that Weldon Cupp, a Minor, who is over the age of Eighteen years, be, and ~~his~~ is relieved of the Disabilities of Nonage, and he is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which he is entitled; to purchase real or personal Estate, to sell and to convey, and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if he were twenty-one years of age.

It is further decreed that the said Weldon Cupp, pay the costs of this proceeding, for which Execution may issue.
