Ruth Hayes, a widow for and in consideration of the sum of one dollars (\$1.00) to me in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a copopration, the reciept whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary for the transmissiion of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby County, Alabama:

20 A in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec 1 Tp 22 R 1 W.

Together with allthe right sand privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment oreuse t ereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
