GRANTED, BARGAINED, AND SOLD and by these presents do hereby GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL AND CONVEY unto the said J.L. Hill, his heirs and assigns, the following described Real Estate, situated in the county of Shelby and State of Alabama, to-wit:

One lot or parcel of land being the East part of Lot 7 in Block 2 according to J.H. Dunston's map of Calera, Alabama, fronting on 17 avenue 75 feet and described as beginning at the northwest corner of lot 6 and run west 75 feet thence south 50 feet to lot No. 8 thence East 75 feet to west line of lot No. 6, thence North 50 feet to 17 avenue, the point of beginning.
