This agreement entered into this the 23rd day of April 1946 by and between Jim Lee <u>presentation</u> as party of the first part & Clydge Wallace as party of the second part, witnesseth: For and in consideration of the sum of ONE THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the parties of the first part do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part all of the merchantable timber standing, lying and being on the following real estate, to-wit:
