For the same consideration the party of the first part does do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the party of the second part the right to ingress and egress on over and across said lands for the purpose of cutting and removing said timber, also the right to have and use such roads and rights of way, log and lumber yards and mill sites as may be necessary and convenient in the cutting and removing of said timber. All rights herein conveyed are for a period of 2 years from the date of this conveyance, and at the expiration of said time all timber not cut and removed shall revert to the then owners of said lands.

To have and to hold unto the party of the second part from the time herein specified, and I do for myself and my heirs and assigns covenant with the party of the second part that I have a good and lawful right to sell and convey said property and that same is free from all incumbrance and I will for myself and my heirs and assigns warrant and defend the title to said property against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever.
