

TRANSMISSION LINE PERMIT

We, M. S. Coats and wife, Mamie Coats for and in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars (\$1.00) to us in hand paid by Alabama Power Company, a corporation, the receipt whereof is acknowledged, do hereby grant to said Alabama Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain its lines of poles and towers and appliances necessary in connection therewith, as located by the final location survey heretofore made by said Company, for the transmission of electric power with the right to string thereon from time to time electric power and telephone wires and the right to permit other corporations and persons to attach wires to said poles and towers upon, over and across the following described lands situated in Shelby county, Alabama:

Tract: begin at a point in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ near where a certain bayou empties into Peavine Creek 200 yards East of L. & N. bridge over said creek and run along said creek to where it crosses $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line of Section 24, and on east side of said NW $\frac{1}{4}$; thence North along $\frac{1}{4}$ Section; thence West along Section line to top of mountain thence south along top of Mountain to bayou near end of mountain; thence along bayou to where it empties into Peavine creek to beginning, 60 acres. Section 24, Township 20, Range 3 West.

Together with all the rights and privileges necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment or use thereof, including the right of ingress and egress to and from said lines; and also the right to cut and keep clear all trees, and to keep clear other obstructions, that may injure or endanger said lines.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to the said Company, its successors and assigns forever.
