Jeter, who is known to me, and who, having been by me first duly sworn says; I have known the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ; all of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  that lies East or Northeast of Mayberry Creek and NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ ; all in Section 11, Township 24, Range 11 East in Shelby County, Alabama, except since change in County line about 1907, I am told the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of SE $\frac{1}{4}$  lying East or Northeast of Mayberry Creek is in Bibb County, Alabama.
