Before the undersigned authority personally appeared J. I. Reid, who is known to me, and who being by me first duly sworn depose and says:

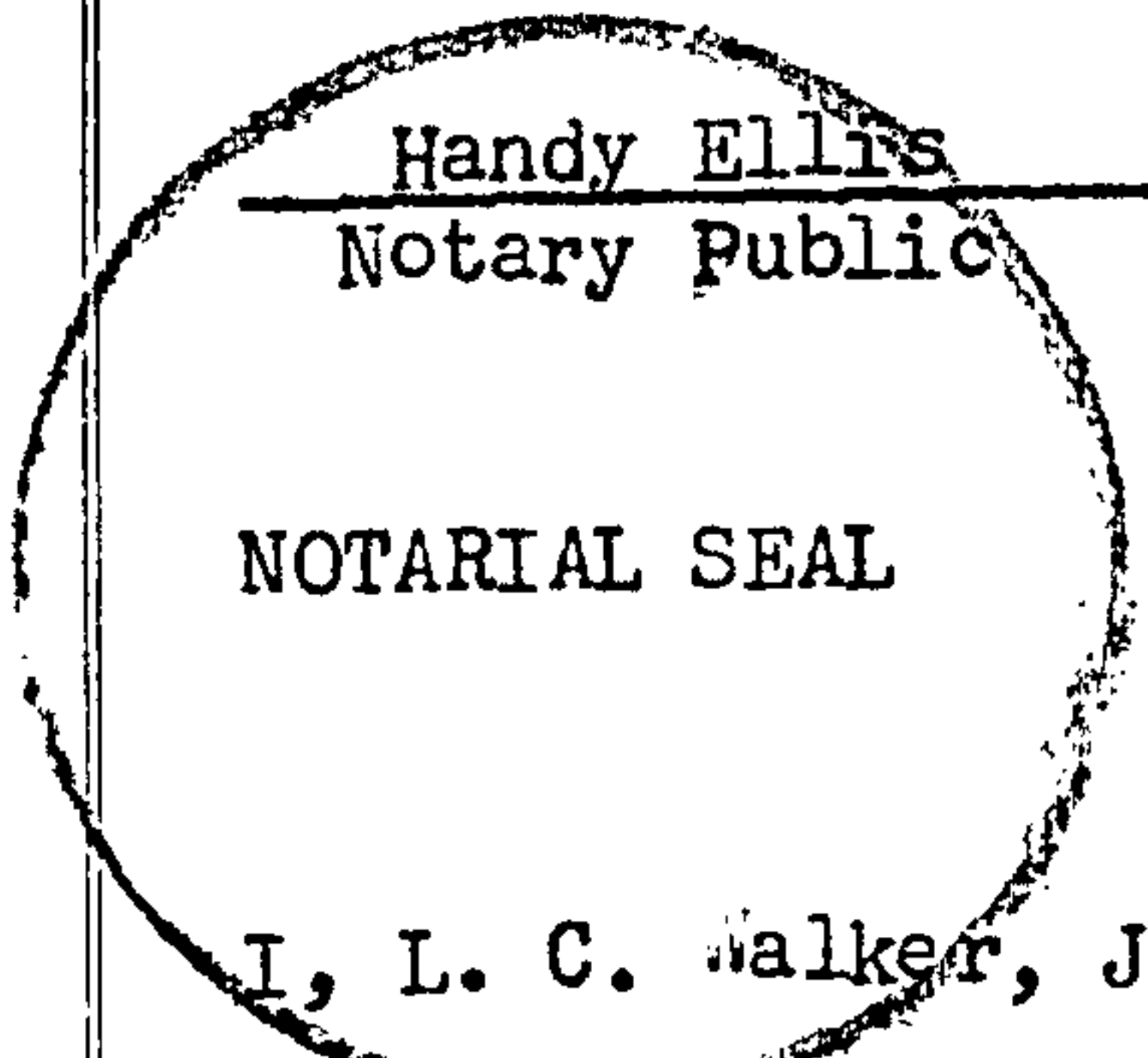
I am the same person as John I. Reid who is grantee in that certain deed dated February 2, 1911, and executed by W. E. Denson and wife, Mollie, and which is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 47 page 466.

The property described in said deed fronts seventy-five feet on Middle Street and 150 feet on Alabama Street, and is lot 7 of block 51, according to map or plat of Reynolds addition to the Town of Montevallo, Alabama, as is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. At the time of the execution of the above mentioned deed, it was delivered to me and immediately thereafter I went into possession of said property. There was a house on it and I had it occupied and was in possession of it and lived upon it myself, both continuously, until I sold it and deed it to Clemmie White on April 12, 1919. During all that time I was in possession of said property, living on it myself, or had tenants on it, and I had actual, open, notorious, continuous, exclusive, adverse possession until I deeded it to said Clemmie White.
