Whereas, on September 7, 1935, Mrs. S. J. Henderson, a widow, executed a deed to N. E. Jones, W. N. Campbell and H. L. Poole, Trustees, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 99 page 75, and,

whereas, it is provided that when said land therein conveyed is not used for religious or other legal purposes, title shall revert to grantor, and,

whereas, grantor has hereto fore conveyed said property to Earle Morgan by deed dated July 24, 1940, and recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book 109 page 31, and,

whereas, said Trustees has ceased to use said property for the purpose and for which it was granted; now therefore, in consideration of the premises in the sum of \$1.00 to said Trustees in hand paid by Earle Morgan, the receipt of which is acknowledged, the said N. E. Jones, W. N. Campbell, and H. L. Poole, Trustees, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto said Earle Morgan the property under consideration, viz:-

A certain parcel or plot of land in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 31, Tp. 19,

Range 2 West, in Shelby County, Alabama, described as follows:

Commence at a section corner, at the N.W. corner of said Sec. 31,

Tp. 19, Range 2 West and run south along said section line fourteen chains

to point of beginning (on the north side of the old "charted" Birmingham and Montgomery Highway) thence continue south along said section line 3 chains to the north side of the new Birmingham and Montgomery paved

Highway, thence easterly along the north side of said new Highway four chains, thence northerly 1 1/2 chains to an Iron Stake on the northside of said old highway, thence northwesterly along north side of old Highway 6 chains and forty links to point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, to the said Earl Morgan, his heirs and assigns forever.
