AFFIDAVIT

Before me, the undersigned authority in and for said County and said State, personally appeared John R. Montgomery, who, after being by me first duly sworn to speak the truth, deposes and says:

My name is John R. Montgomery, I formerly owned the land described below and during the time I owned said land I made some mortgages to Citizens State Bank, Vincent, Alabama. Said bank has been closed for several years. One of the mortgages made by me to said bank was dated September 17, 1927 and was due September 17, 1928. It was for \$324.00 and was recorded in Mortgage Book 141, page 432 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Al Alabama. This mortgage was paid in full by me and I have the mortgage in my possession. I made another mortgage to said bank on January 2, 1930 for \$540.00 on which the last payment was due December 31, 1930. This mortgage was recorded in Mortgage Book 158, page 554 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama. I also paid this mortgage in full, but do not have the mortgage in my possession. It has somehow been misplaced. Mr. Eddie Harris, Vincent, Alabama, was employed by the bank at the time I paid this mortgage. He also remembers the occassion when it was paid. Said land is discribed as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner of Mrs. D.C. Davis' lot and running West 420 feet; thence North 95 feet; thence East 420 feet; thence South along Section line 95 feet to the starting point, being situated in Shelby County, Alabama.

Affiant further says that the lot described below is the same as that described above, except that a strip 114 feet widechas been sold off the West side of said lot. Said lot is described as follows:

Begin at the NE corner of NE4 of NE4 of Section 15, Township 19, Range 2 East and run South along said 40 acre line 378, 2/3 feet to the beginning point; thence run West 306 feet; thence South 95 feet; thence East 306 feet to said 40 acre line to a point which is also the Northeast corner of Mrs. D. C. Davis' lot; thence North along said line 95 feet to the beginning point; said lot has sometime heretofore been described as Lot 60 of W.J. Horsley's Map of Vincent, Alabama; said lot being situated in the NE4 of NE4, Section 15, Tawnship 19, Range 2 East, Shelby County Alabama.

Affiant further says, I am familiar with the deed from M. L. Kidd and husband, J. M. Kidd to D. H. Wilder, recorded in Deed Book 65 page 513 in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, and I am familiar with the alley mentioned on the margin of the record where said deed is recorded. The said alley did not come within several hundred feet of the above described lot.
