I am one of the grantors in that certain deed executed by Dean Edwards and other to C. E. Jones on the 9th df August, 1938, which deed is recorded in the Probate Office of Shelby County, Alabama, in deed book lll at page 77. I was acquainted with Walter Dean who owned the land conveyed in the aforementioned deed, and he died on or about the 26 day of February, 1937. Mr. Dean left surviving him no widow, no children, or desecendants of children. He had several brothers and two sister, both of which died before Walter Dean and one left no descendants, but the brothers all died prior to his death, and left surviving them no children or descendants of children. He had one sister, Sarah Louise Edwards, who also died before Mr. Walter Dean, and she had two children as follows:-
