IN THE MATTER OF THE PETITION OF James Kirkland, to have Freddie Kirkland, a minor, RELIEVED OF THE DISABILITIES OF NONAGE etc.

This cause coming on to be heard and having been submitted for Decree on the Petition and ex-parte affidavits of James Kirkland and Percy Edmondson, thereupon, upon consideration thereof, it is ordered, adjudged, and decreed by the Court that Freddie Kirkland, a Minor, who is over the age of Eighteen years, be, and he is Relieved of the Disabilities of Nonage, and he is vested with the power to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to receive and take possession of any real and personal property to which he is entitled; to purchase Real or Personal Estate, to sell and to convey, and to do all things, and to all intents and purposes as effectually as if he were twenty-one years of age.

It is further decreed that the said Freddie Kirkland, pay the costs of this proceeding, for which Execution may issue.
