George Duadleston being duly sworn on oath says:

That affiant on fugust 21, 1928 purchased from Arlington Gardner and from Calvin R. Rasco and others the NW4 of NE4, Sec. 32, T. 19, R. 1 E. in said County and received from them separate deeds conveying said lands to affiant; said deeds having been heretofore recorded in Deed Book 83 page 248 and Deed Book 86 page 612 in the Office of the Probate Judge of said County and that on May 51, 1926 affiant purchased from Allan Land Co., the NE4 of NW4, Sec. 32, T. 19, R. 1 E. in said County and received from such seller a deed conveying said lands to affiant which deed was recorded in Deed Book 80 page 423 in the Office of the Probate Judge of said County.

That afficiant as of the dates of such deeds went into possession of the lands conveyed by such deeds and remained in open, notorious, exclusive and adverse possession thereof under the claim that afficiant owned same continuously down until efficiant conveyed such lands to W. B. Webster and Mrs. Maggie Gulledge Webster in exptember, 1941 as shown by deeds recorded in Deed Book 115 pages 501 and 502 in the Uffice of the Probate Judge of said County. That during all of such time said lands were open and unfenced woodland without any buildings thereon; that afficiant's possession consisted in going over such lands, posting notices thereon against trespassing, offering such lands for sale; granting to Alabama Power Co., a right of way for power line over same and to Plantation Pipe Line Co., a right of way for a pipe line over said llands and that afficiant upon receiving said deeds to said lands regularly returned same for taxes to the Tex Assessor of Shelby County for every year and paid the taxes assessed thereon for every year down to and including the year ended October 1st, 1941 after afficiant's deed to Webster.

That during affiant's ownership of said lands as aforesaid no person other than affiant ever

claimed ownership of any part of said lands or was in possession of any part of same or assessed same for taxation or paid taxes thereon; that said lands were known to persons living in the vicinity thereof as affiant's lands and were known to the officials of said Younty as affiant's lands.
